## Key Stage 1 SATs Results 2018

At the end of KS1 (Yr2), teachers are required to assess each child in the areas of reading, writing, maths and science. National Curriculum assessment tests are used to support teachers' judgements. The current measures are as follows:

**Expected Standard** – Working at the expected standard for a child at the end of Year 2

**Greater Depth** – Working at greater depth within the expected standard, with a strong understanding of the curriculum.

## Key Stage 2 SATs Results 2018

Children in Year 6 are assessed on their knowledge and understanding of the curriculum. The curriculum introduced in 2014 provides greater challenge with higher expectations set for the end of KS2.

Year 6 pupils are assessed in reading, writing, grammar, punctuation and spelling and maths.

Children are awarded one of the following Teacher Assessment judgements in writing:

**Expected Standard** - Working at the expected standard for their age

**Greater Depth** - Working at greater depth within the expected standard and has a strong understanding of the curriculum.
