Asia is the largest continent. It has the biggest land area and the world's biggest population. There are 48 countries in Asia.

Australia is the smallest continent.

<u>Africa</u> is the continent that has the most countries. There are 54 countries on the African continent.


North America is made up of 23 countries.

<u>South America</u> has 12 countries. Its largest country is Brazil.

<u>Europe</u> houses the two smallest countries in the world: Vatican City Monaco. There are 44 countries in Europe.
