



Animals



- There are animals on every continent in the world.
- Wild animals are not the same as pets. Wild animals live outside and don't always have people looking after them.
- Each species looks different and they have different features to help them survive in their natural habitat.
- Some animals can camouflage. This is so that they can hide and/ or hunt.
- Some animals live in zoos. Zoos are important places that help protect species and teach people about animals.
- Zookeepers and vets are responsible for the animals and keep them clean and healthy.

Habitat	The environment in which an animal lives
Diet	What an animal eats
Adaptation	How an animal has developed over time to be best suited to its habitat
Carnivore	An animal which eats meat
Omnivore	An animal which eats meat and plants
Herbivore	An animal which eats plants
Savannah	A grassy plain with few trees - generally hot and dry with intermittent rainfall
Polar regions	Arctic and Antarctic - these regions are generally cold and icy with features such as glaciers and ice bergs
Desert	Hot dry areas with very few plants and infrequent rainfall
Rainforest	An area of tall, mainly evergreen trees and a high amount of rainfall
Camouflage	How an animal conceals itself in its environment.
