### Key skills Personal, social and emotional development

- ☐ To understand the rules and routines in the Pre-School
- ☐ To be confident to talk to other children and unfamiliar people
- ☐ To begin to accept the needs of others, taking turns and sharing
- ☐ To be friendly to each other, initiating conversations and forming good relationships with peers and familiar adults.

### Key skills Communication and language

- ☐ To respond to simple instructions
- ☐ To listen to others in a small group
- ☐ To begin to use more complex sentences when talking
- ☐ To use talk to talk about what might happen next for example in a story.

### Key skills Literacy

- ☐ To begin to give meanings to the marks they make
- ☐ To listen to stories with increasing attention and recall

### Key skills Mathematics

- ☐ To use some number names and number language spontaneously
- ☐ To use some number names accurately in play
- ☐ To show an interest in shape and space by playing with shapes or making arrangements with objects
- ☐ Recognise numerals 1-5

### Key skills Understanding the world

- ☐ To show an interest in different occupations and ways of life
- ☐ Comments and ask questions about the natural world
- ☐ Knows how to operate simple equipment e.g. turns on a CD player

- ☐ To explore colour and how colour can be changed
