Hope

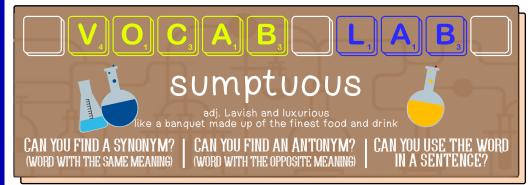
