The children in Mulberry and Hawthorn classes will have PE on Tuesdays and Thursdays this term. Please ensure they have their PE kits in school on these days.

The children in Sycamore class will continue to have PE on Mondays and Thursdays. The children will need to bring their PE kits to school on Monday. On Thursday, they will need to come to school wearing their PE kits and bring their school uniform to change into later in the day.

Reading

The children will continue to read weekly with a teacher or teaching assistant as part of a small group. Please ensure they bring their reading book and diary into school every day. These may be beyond their reading ability and are to be shared with an adult to further promote a love of reading.
